
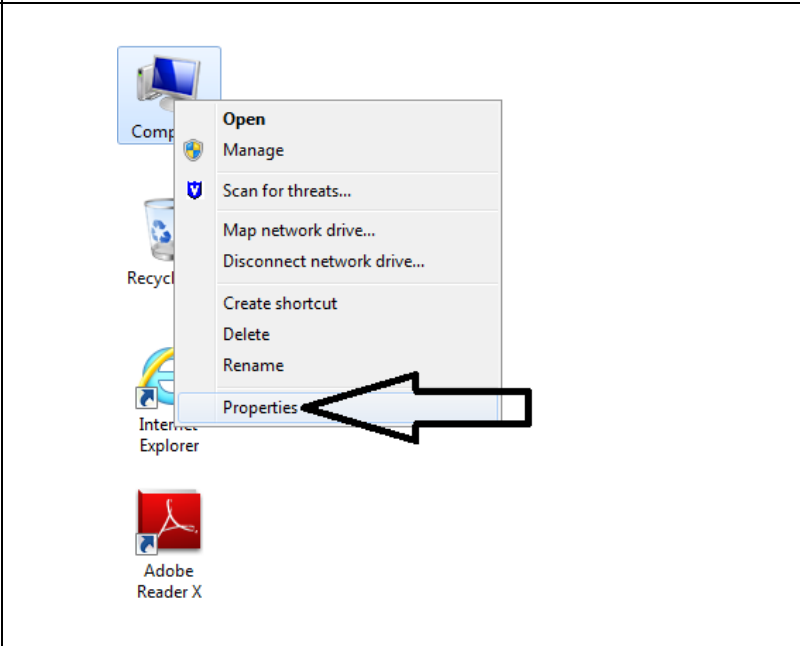


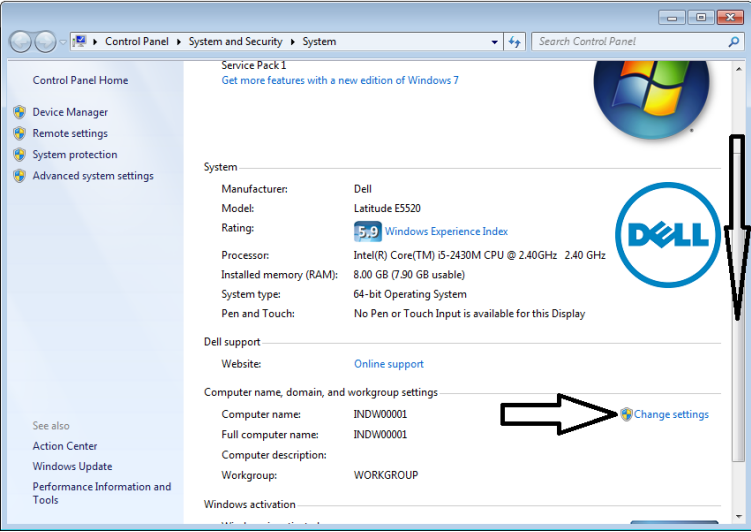
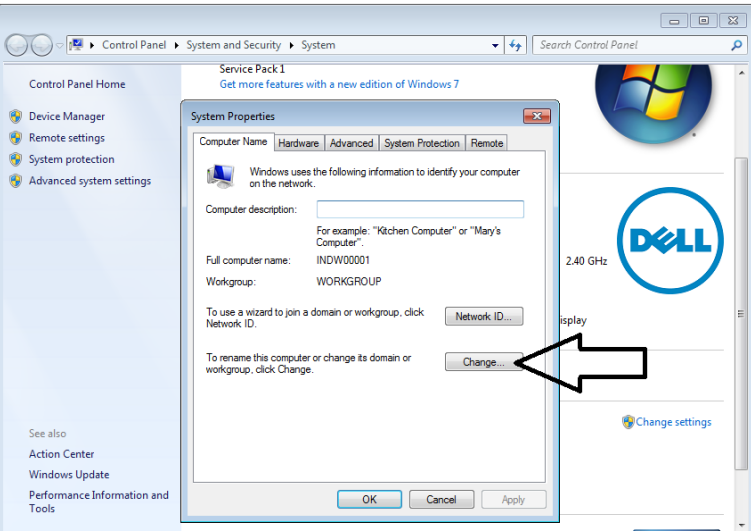
## Change the Machine Name

When a new computer has been deployed, it is necessary for the recipient of the new equipment/hardware to rename that computer. State of Indiana Department of Health has developed a naming convention for all of the computers used by the Indiana WIC offices.

This work instruction will walk you through the renaming of your computer.

### Task

| Step | Action  | Result   |

| 1.   | <p>On the computer desktop, find the "Computer" icon and RIGHT mouse click.</p> <p>A popup menu is displayed.</p> |   |
| 2.   | <p>Click the <b>Properties</b> option.</p> <p>The System page is displayed.</p>                                   |  |

| <p>3.</p> | <p>Scroll down to the Computer name, domain, and workgroup settings area of the screen.</p> <p>On the right side of the screen, left click the <b>Change settings</b> icon/link.</p> <p>The System Properties dialog screen is displayed</p> |   |
| <p>4.</p> | <p>On the Computer Name tab, click the "Change" button.</p> <p>The Computer Name/Domain Changes dialog box is displayed.</p>   |  |

| <p>5.</p>                     | <p>Type in the new Computer name.</p> <p><b>Note:</b> The new names per State of Indiana Department of Health; Desktop names begin with DT00 and the Laptop names begin with LT00. Be certain that you do not name the computer with a name that is already in use as this will cause issues when connecting to other computers in the network.</p> <p>Click the <b>OK</b> button.</p> <p>The Computer Name/Domain Changes dialog box is closed that the System Properties dialog box is re-displayed.</p> |  |
| <p>6.</p>                     | <p>Click the <b>Apply</b> and <b>OK</b> buttons.</p> <p>Close the System windows and restart your computer.</p>  |  |
